

For high school students enrolled in a COS course, it is important to note that a student's IEP or 504 Plan *will NOT* automatically carry over to the COS course. Students wanting to use K12 accommodations/disability services for the COS course must sign up with the Access & Ability Center to authorize the use of accommodations in the COS course.

\*Note: A common K12 accommodation may include course or assignment modification. Course or assignment modifications are NOT an authorized accommodation for any college course. If the instructor is a college instructor, the course is a college course.

If interested in joining the Access & Ability Center, you will need to:

- 1) Complete the COS Online Application at [www.cos.edu](http://www.cos.edu).
- 2) Turn in a copy of your IEP, a copy of your 504 Plan, or some other documentation of a health condition or disability. You can email it to [kyleca@cos.edu](mailto:kyleca@cos.edu), or you can bring it into our office in North Sequoia, Room 10, at College of the Sequoias between the hours of 8am and 4:30pm Monday through Friday.
- 3) Complete an AAC Intake Form with your name, address, and some other information. We will give you a call to schedule an intake appointment at the phone number you provide for us.
- 4) Show up for your appointment! You will get to meet with an AAC Counselor, who will help you plan classes and plan your authorized AAC services with you.
