Engineering & Design

Architecture courses emphasize skills in design, visual communication, history and construction technology. Students completing the program transfer to four-year, university-accredited architecture programs or obtain entry-level employment in architectural or related fields. Skills related to predesign, conceptual design, schematic design, design development, building information modeling (BIM), computer-assisted drafting and design (CADD), construction materials and methods, construction documents, detailing, and tactile (by hand) and digital model-making and drawing will be conveyed through the coursework.

The Drafting Technology Program prepares students for entry-level employment and/or potential further study in the field with courses in drafting technology, architecture, computers and graphic design. Students will acquire skills, knowledge and abilities in computer-aided drafting (CAD), visual communication, computer concepts, graphic design and construction technology.
