Building Trades & Construction

Construction Technology prepares students for entry-level employment and/or potential further study of building trades and also prepares students for inspection certification tests and for entry-level building inspection employment. The Construction Inspection degree will also earn two years credit toward the four year experience requirement for a general building contractor's license.

Electrician Training prepares students for entry-level employment in the field of Electrician Training. Students completing this certificate will acquire skills in the principles of electricity, circuitry, power distribution, and electrical building and safety codes. This program also prepares individuals for the California Electrician Certification Examination as part of the electrician certification process required by the State of California.

Environmental Control Technology training prepares students for entry-level employment and/or potential further study in the field of Environmental Control Technology. Students completing this degree will have a foundation in the field(s) of heating, ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC) through the study of modern refrigeration and will acquire essential HVAC skills.
