### Fashion & Interior Design

COS offers the only Fashion Design & Merchandising program located in the Central Valley. The Fashion Program provides classes for people interested in fashion merchandising, fashion design and clothing construction. The program focuses on a wide range of skills for students that want careers in the fashion industry. Course content revolves around pattern making, tailoring, sewing, fashion design, visual merchandising and textiles. These classes lead to an associate degree and/or two certificates.

The COS Cosmetology Program is offered through a partnership with the Estes Institute of Cosmetology (estescosmetology.com). The cosmetology course takes approximately 11 months to complete and covers hair and nail styling, skin beauty care and business skills.

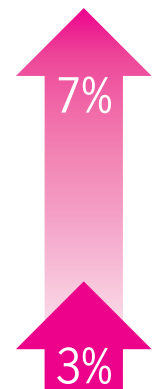
