A Certificate of Achievement in Veterinary Assisting is attainable in just 24 units. Students will gain skills in animal handling, restraint, laboratory specimen collection and testing, pharmacy skills, record keeping, nursing care and treatment, and how to operate equipment.

Opening the career opportunity for jobs as a veterinary receptionist, veterinary assistant, veterinary kennel attendant. This program provides a foundation of knowledge and skills for further veterinary education as a registered veterinary technician or veterinary school.

Upon completion of the program, students can start a career at an entry level pay of \$15-21 an hour.


