- \$ 1,104.00 Enrollment fee (12 units X \$46 X 2 Semesters)
 - 8,304.00 Non-resident tuition fee (12 units x \$273 X 2 Semesters. Effective Fall 2024)
 - 40.00 Health Fee (on campus health center)
 - 10.00 Student Center Fee
 - 21.00 Transit Fee
 - 2.00 Student Representation Fee
 - 950.00 Medical Insurance (varies by age, chosen coverage and insurance company)
 - 1,800.00 Books and Supplies (depends on class requirements)
 - 3,000.00 Personal Expenses
 - 13,880.00 Room and Board (COS does NOT offer housing)
 - 1,200.00 Transportation

Medical Insurance Coverage

Each applicant accepted for admission is <u>required</u> to purchase health and accident insurance coverage to cover the period of his/her enrollment at COS.
