- 1. Call to Order Josh McDonnell called the meeting to order at 3:05. Self-introductions were done by all.
- 2. Public Comments-None
- 3. Minutes of September 20, 2023- Larry Dutto moved to approve the minutes of 3/22/23 and Alexis Silveria seconded the motion. No further discussion. Motion carried.
- **4. Financial Report**-Rainbow Park-Moore reviewed the 1st and 2nd quarter financial reports for 2023-24 and pointed out that the majority of the expenditures were for the construction contractor. We are on track with having 85% of the funds spent within three years of issuance (currently almost 95% spent). There were no questions.
- 5. Proposition 39 General Obligation Bond Audit Report-June 30, 2023 Rainbow Park-Moore reviewed the 22-23 bond audit. She pointed out that there were no findings to the audit. This is the best audit we can receive.

 Brent Calvin pointed out that this project was double what was remaining in Measure J funds and the additional dollars are being paid from District reserves (approximately \$18M-\$20M).

Larry Dutto moved to accept the Prop 39 audit report and Alexis Silveria seconded the motion. No further discussion. Motion carried.

There was discussion about equipment for the new buildings and possible different funding sources. Strong Workforce dollars were used to purchase materials and those will be moved into the new building. Quite a bit of the existing equipment will also be moved into the new building.
