The Bachelor of Science in Nursing prepares you to take your associate degree in nursing to the next level and become a leader in your profession. You'll also learn about community and public health nursing, as well as nursing research processes. Leadership instruction includes conflict management.

Career Opportunities

Graduates from the BSN program are prepared for advanced nursing positions throughout the health care industry, as well as administrator positions in hospitals, clinics, doctors' offices, and retirement centers. They are also qualified to pursue graduate studies in nursing.
