What is an FSA ID?

- * Electronic signature for Student and Parent
- * Allows connection to IRS Data Retrieval Tool from FAFSA
- * Get your FSA ID at fsaid.ed.gov

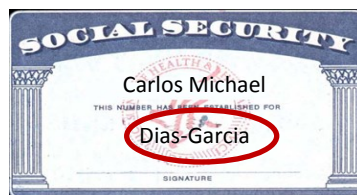


Who Needs an FSA ID?

- * Student applying for aid
- * One parent whose information is included on the FAFSA

Keep in Mind

- * Parent and student must use different email addresses
- * Use a personal email, not high school email
- * Parent without a Social Security Number can't create an FSA ID and must print, sign, and mail a signature page to Federal Student Aid
- * Name and Social Security Number on SS card must match ID and FAFSA. Two last names?

Step 9: Verify your E-mail address. A code will be sent to your E-mail that you provided. Type in the code from the E-mail and "verify".

Remember that you only create an FSA ID if you have Social Security Number (SSN). Students with DACA SSN need to complete a Dream Act Application. Only 1 of your parents needs to create an FSA ID as well if they have a Social Security Number. If your parents don't have an SSN, they will sign your FAFSA with a printed out signature page.
