Alumni Engagement with Marketing Firm, Interact Communications

- o The initial step is to conduct surveys, both online and in small focus groups
- The COS Foundation Board is one of the focus groups along with
 - Current students
 - Alumni
 - Business and Civic Leaders
 - Key Administrators and Faculty
 - and some one-on-one with Key Individuals
- Email survey to be distributed to the alumni database (37,000) donors (4,500) and current COS students (17,000)
- Survey questions have been devised for both email and focus groups, both to begin in October.
- Following the completion of these surveys and executive summary will be developed and presented to the Board.

New Fundraising Platform eTeamSponsors' FundRaker

- o Email, text, social media fundraising platform for crowd fundraising
- Shifting sports teams and some programs away from events, candy sales and the like toward outright campaigning for charitable gifts
- Fully integrated with our donor management software, we will build our donor database
- Standard form asks if the donor is an alumnus of COS, adding to the alumni database capturing abilities of the Foundation
- Initial investment \$5,995; renewals rate is 9% of prior year's gross donations generated from through the system

Fresno State Visalia Campus – Integrated Teacher Education Program Expansion

- o The campus now is home to an accelerated teacher credential program.
- The program allows individuals with an AA degree to enroll and in two years, they will have earned their bachelor's degree and a multi-subject teaching credential.
- It has started its third cohort this fall.
- The COS Foundation has been providing a financial incentive for COS students to transfer into the program in hopes that the program will grow.
- Last year there were 35 students enrolled in the program and 27 of them were COS transfer students.
- o This fall, the program enrolled 49 students and 43 were COS transfer students.
- o Each COS transfer student received a \$1,000 scholarship.
- So far the COS Foundation has awarded \$70,000 in scholarships to invest in the local training of teachers and the gainful employment of our COS graduates.
- The increased enrollment levels and the canceled Brew Fest are going to make it very difficult to perpetuate this incentive through 2021.
