Nomination

College of the Sequoias established a Hall of Fame in 1987 to recognize its distinguished staff and alumni. Each year three to five people will be selected based on their contributions to such fields as academics, the community, athletics, professional occupations, and the arts.

Any person may nominate a candidate to the Hall of Fame. Once a name has been placed in nomination, it shall be kept on file and be eligible for committee consideration in later years.

Any former COS student, employee or board of trustee member, living or deceased, who has gained local, statewide, national or international recognition in any area of endeavor may be considered. The selection for each Hall of Fame will be from nominees who were associated with COS at least ten years prior to the induction year.
