

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS FOR DEGREES AND CERTIFICATES

The **Sequoias Community College** District grants the degrees of Associate in Arts and Associate in Science to those students who have completed the subject requirements for graduation and who have maintained a 2.0 average in subjects attempted. Students must also complete the general education, residency, and competency requirements set forth in Title 5 regulations.

Students may be awarded a Certificate of Achievement upon successful completion of a minimum of **16** ~~48~~ or more semester units of degree-applicable coursework. Such coursework will serve as a pattern of learning experiences designed to develop certain capabilities that may be oriented to career or general education.

The Superintendent/President shall establish procedures to determine degree and certificate requirements that include appropriate involvement of the curriculum committee. The procedures shall assure that graduation requirements are published ~~electronically or in print~~ in the District catalog and **included in other resources that are convenient for students.**
