IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- This form does not take the place of a counselor. The material in this publication has been prepared as carefully as possible. College of the Sequoias does not assume responsibility for inaccuracies or changes in the information contained herein after the date of publication.
- All coursework used for CAL-GETC must be completed with a "C" grade or better, and each course must have a minimum value of 3 units/4 quarter units.
- CAL-GETC may not be appropriate for all transfer majors. It is highly recommended that students meet with a counselor and/or consult with individual campuses prior to selecting courses.
 - UC Berkeley - CAL-GETC is not accepted by the Haas School of Business nor the College of Engineering. CAL-GETC does not fully satisfy lower-division breadth requirements for majors in the College of Chemistry nor the College of Natural Resources.
 - UC Davis - All undergraduate colleges accept CAL-GETC. However, for the Bachelor of Science degrees and selective majors, CAL-GETC is not recommended; students should focus instead of completing major preparation and taking UC Davis general education pattern courses as time permits.
 - UC Irvine - All Schools accept CAL-GETC.
 - UC Los Angeles - All Schools accept CAL-GETC. However, completion of CAL-GETC is not required/encouraged for students applying to the School of Engineering; engineering students are instead encouraged to focus on lower-division major preparation prior to transfer. For the School of Nursing and the School of Theater, Film, and Television, CAL-GETC is required.
 - UC Merced - CAL-GETC is strongly discouraged but is accepted by the School of Engineering; students are encouraged to focus on lower-division major preparation. CAL-GETC is not recommended but accepted by the School of Natural Sciences; students are encouraged to focus on lower-division major preparation. CAL-GETC is recommended for the School of Social Sciences, Humanities, and Arts; students are encouraged to complete as much lower-division major preparation as possible.
 - UC Riverside - CAL-GETC is recommended for the College of Humanities, Arts, and Social Sciences. The School of Business Administration requires CAL-GETC. CAL-GETC is acceptable for the College of Natural and Agricultural Sciences and the Marlan and Rosemary Bourns College of Engineering; some additional coursework may be required after enrollment.
 - UC San Diego - CAL-GETC clears all lower-division GE requirements for John Muir, Earl Warren, Eleanor Roosevelt, Thurgood Marshall, and Sixth Colleges; some upper-division courses will be required after enrollment. For Revelle College, CAL-GETC does not clear all lower-division GE requirements; students with CAL-GETC must complete 3 courses in mathematics and 5 courses in natural science before transfer or while enrolled at UCSD.
 - UC Santa Barbara - CAL-GETC is acceptable for the College of Letters and Science and College of Creative Studies. College of Engineering students are encouraged to focus on major preparation rather than general education, but may use CAL-GETC to substitute for general education requirements. Students planning to transfer to UCSB into a major in biological or physical sciences, economics, engineering, computer science, mathematics, statistics, or psychology must be careful to complete lower-division major preparation courses to ensure competitiveness and make normal, timely progress through the major.
 - UC Santa Cruz -For majors in engineering and the physical and biological sciences, CAL-GETC is not recommended. Students should ensure completion of lower-division courses for their intended major as indicated in the UCSC Catalog and on assist.org.
- Area 4: Continuing students (entering before Fall 2023) who maintain continuous enrollment (or catalog rights) are not required to complete Area 7. However, continuing students must complete 9 semester (or 12 quarter) units from Area 4 (from at least two different disciplines) for full GE certification and transfer degrees.
- Area 7: New students entering Fall 2023 and thereafter will be required to complete this area for full GE certification and transfer degrees.
- Courses may be used to fulfill only one General Education area, with the exception of Area 6: Language other than English requirement.
- Courses used to fulfill General Education may double count with courses used to fulfill a major requirement.
- Courses on this list are approved for the academic year 2025-2026, which is valid beginning Fall 2025 through Summer 2026.
- Students wishing to use a course to meet a CAL-GETC general education requirement must ensure that it is approved for the academic year in which it is taken.

- Each CSU/UC campus will have additional graduation requirements outside the lower division CAL-GETC
- A General Education (GE) Certification is an official document from the College of the Sequoias that certifies a student completing lower division general education breadth.
- Certification is not automatic - students must [request certification](#). Students may request certification after acceptance to a CSU/UC.
 - Official transcripts from all other accredited institutions attended must be on file and will be reviewed for inclusion in the certification process.
 - A minimum of 34 semester units is required for a complete certification.
 - All official transcripts including college, high school, AP, and IB test scores are required.
- Confirm with a COS Counselor if you meet transfer admission eligibility.
