



Equity Review Updates:

- From 8/1/23, 122 of 184 courses completed or in-progress were reviewed for equity (66%).
- Last year, by mid-April, 41 course reviews completed.
- Still work to do! Some reviews check yes, but description is thin – "yes" entered in the text field, or other non-specific response.


