What is Credit for Prior Learning and how are units awarded across college institutions?

- 1. AP or Advance Placement Exam- College Board Examinations and widely accepted by all universities
 - a. *COS already has a process
- 2. **IB or International Baccalaureate Program and Exam** Administered by a non-profit organization and offered in a high schools around the area. Widely accepted by all universities.
 - a. *COS is updating this policy to award credit
- 3. **CLEP- College Level Examination Program**-Gives credit towards five general examinations and is currently in the catalog.
 - a. *COS is updating this policy to award credit.
 - b. *UC will not allow CLEP credit and we cannot certify IGETC
 - c. *CSU's do accept the credit towards admissions and general education. A score of 50 must be achieved.
- 4. **JST or Joint Service Transcripts** synchronized transcript that presents data for the United States Army, Marine Corp, Navy and Coast Guard and includes:
 - a. Personal service member data
 - b. Military course completions—all courses that have been evaluated by the American Council on Education (ACE), with full descriptions and credit recommendations
 - i. *CSU generally grants credit towards baccalaureate units.
 - *UC may award lower-division (freshman/sophomore level) units for military courses completed if the courses are consistent with University policy on awarding transfer credit when there is an equivalent course taught at a UC campus. UC will consult the ACE recommendations for information regarding course content and as a guide to the awarding of credit. <u>Credit for military courses is determined after matriculation at UC therefor CCC's should not use CPL credit to certify IGETC or meet UC transfer eligibility requirements.</u>
 - c. Military occupations-full descriptions, skill levels, and credit recommendations
 - i. Industry credentials and potentially portfolios To be determined by CSU not accepted at UC.
 - d. College level test scores—CLEP, DSST, DANTE Administered Exams
 - i. *UC does not accept CLEP, DANTE administered exams, or DSST credit towards admissions. CSU may accept credit towards G.E. or electives.
 - e. Other learning experiences—additional completed courses and occupations that have not been evaluated by ACE for college credit
 - i. Industry credentials and potentially portfolios To be determined by CSU not accepted at UC.
 - ii. NCPACE Online correspondence courses offered to the Navy. To be determined by CSU not accepted at UC
 - f. An academic institution courses transcript- Not necessary for CPL since the course work is from an accredited institution.

- 5. **Industry Recognized Credentials** evaluation of knowledge gained outside the classroom within a specific industry that is translated over into a specific college course.
 - a. *To be determined by CSU not accepted at UC at this time.
- 6. **Student Created Portfolios** Compilation of knowledge gained outside the classroom within a specific area that is translated over into a specific college course.
 - a. *To be determined by CSU not accepted at UC at this time.
