- 1. Update on Canvas Implementation for COS. Deborah updated the group on the Canvas adoption.
- 2. Discussion and work on Institutional Objectives of the DE Plan.
 - a. We discussed the Institutional Outcomes on page 8 of the DE Plan draft. We changed the term outcomes to commitments.
 - b. We also expect to be able to identify responsible parties, or locus of control). For example, Computer Services would reasonably be expected to Provide 24/7 access to the learning management system and maintain the synchronization of Banner and the learning management system.
 - c. During this discussion, we began to consider administrative structure for distance education. Deborah will provide some organizational models for the next meeting.
 - d. We discussed the existing policies that provide information or support for these commitments. For example, AP 4105 provides information concerning student authentication, Last Day of Attendance (LDA) and regular and effective contact.
 - e. We added an umbrella commitment to meet all accreditation requirements.
