New Course	ART 181 : Survey of Asian Art This course provides a select overview of art and architecture from India, Southeast Asia, China, Korea, and Japan from pre-history to modern times.	Fall 2025		This course is being proposed for inclusion in the AA-T for Art History to align the degree with the TMC in Art History and the ARTH 130 C-ID descriptor. At CSU Fresno, a lower division Asian Art course (Art History 12) is a requirement. Course Modification	FASH 165: CAD for Fashion This course teaches students how to use computer aid design (CAD) software to develop skills in drawing and designing for the fashion industry. Instruction includes the use of Adobe Illustrator, Adobe Photoshop, and Canva. Students will create a portfolio utilizing the CAD software consisting of textile and apparel illustrations to develop a cohesive fashion line. Learn how to develop and create an inspired portfolio that promotes a candidate's skills, strengths, and experience for employment in the fashion industry.
