### **TASKFORCE RECOMMENDATIONS**

#### **Form Academic Senate Standing Committee C**

##### **Charge:**

- Address 10+1 academic and professional matters related to diversity, equity, inclusion, and accessibility (DEIA)

##### **Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:**

- Stay current on DEIA policies and advise Academic Senate (AS) on DEIA changes in the state, title 5, and the Academic Senate for California Community Colleges (ASCCC)
  - Make recommendations to the AS on any changes/developments in DEIA as it relates to 10+1 matters
- Develop an equitable and inclusive way of appointing faculty members to participatory governance
- Advise on how to incorporate more diverse faculty in participatory governance
- Advise faculty (instructional and noninstructional) on DEIA best practices as it relates to their work with students
- Advise/recommend professional development for DEIA
  - Collaborate with FEC to coordinate DEIA professional development as needed
- Collaborate with other groups on campus that are involved in DEIA work (i.e., EDAC, COSTA Equity Chair)
- Offer a zoom option so members of the public can attend the committee meetings

##### **Committee Members (up to 20, unless voted on by the committee to expand):**

- 8 full-time faculty (this total includes senators) appointed by the AS
- 8 part-time faculty (this total includes senators) appointed by the AS
- 1 COSTA representative appointed by COSTA
- 1 COSAFA representative appointed by COSAFA
- 1 classified staff representative appointed by CSEA (non-voting)
- 1 student representative appointed by student senate (non-voting)
- Additional voting and non-voting members will be added as needed by a simple majority vote amongst all members of the committee
