- Using Canvas Studio for students to record oral presentations of their work (care plans are the main tool for evaluation in nursing clinicals). This would be the response to AI use, so that students are not as easily able to just copy & paste material.
 - There is concern that it may be as violation of FERPA if they record themselves dictating these assignments. Do we need to ask for consent? Especially given the context that Zoom video was no longer required for class time during COVID-induced online instruction, because students were concerned it was an invasion of privacy
- Turn it in- how can professors look at student's work and view the report it produces (including the Al detection). Maybe this is an error on Turn it in's end.
