SEQUOIAS CCD Board of Trustees

STUDENT MEMBER

The Board shall include one (1) non-voting student member.

The term of office shall be one year commencing July 1.

The student member must:

- 1. Be a resident of California at the time of the nomination and during the term of their service;
- 2. Be enrolled in and maintain a minimum of twelve (12) semester units in the District at the time of nomination and throughout the term of their service;
- 3. Have a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 at the time of election and throughout their term in office;
- 4. Have a current Student ID card.

The student member elected to the Board shall have the following rights and privileges:

- 1. Be seated with the Board:
- 2. Be recognized as a full member of the Board;
- 3. Be entitled to participate in the discussion of issues and received all materialspresented to members of the Board (except for closed session);
- 4. Be entitled to any mileage allowance necessary to attend board meetings to thesame extent as publicly elected trustees.
- 5. Be entitled to retain employment with the District while service on the Board.

On or before June 1 of each year, the Board shall consider whether to afford the student member any of the following privileges:

- The privilege to make and second motions;
- The privilege to serve a term commencing on July 1.

As a student member elected to the Board, the student board member shall agree to perform the following duties:

- 1. Attend all regular and special meetings of the Board (except closed sessions), participate in the discussion of any or all agenda items;
- 2. Review the agenda of the Board prior to each meeting;
- 3. Confer with leaders of the Student Senate at each District campus prior to each meeting of the Board;
- 4. When appropriate, confer with other student groups that might be affected by subsequent actions of the Board prior to each meeting;

- 5. Consult with students representing student organizations that seek an audience with the Board;
- 6. Seek out and talk with students who attend board meetings;
- 7. Consult with administrators concerning the actions of the Board and identify any need for a policy review or revision;
- 8. Provide feedback to leaders of the Student Senate and to students in general concerning any pending or final Board actions.
