

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS FOR DEGREES AND CERTIFICATES

The Sequoias Community College District grants the degrees of Associate in Arts and Associate in Science to those students who have completed the subject requirements for graduation and who have maintained a 2.0 average in subjects attempted. Students must also complete the general education, residency, and competency requirements set forth in Title 5 regulations.

Students may be awarded a Certificate of Achievement upon successful completion of a minimum of 16 or more semester units of degree-applicable coursework. Such coursework will serve as a pattern of learning experiences designed to develop certain capabilities that may be oriented to career or general education.

The Superintendent/President shall ensure procedures to determine degree and certificate requirements include appropriate involvement of the curriculum committee. The procedures shall assure that graduation requirements are published in the District catalog and included in other resources that are convenient for students. The Superintendent/President will consult with the Academic Senate on Ten Plus One matters as specified in AP/BP 2510.
