

STUDENT SUCCESS AND SUPPORT PROGRAM

The District shall provide Student Success and Support Program (SSSP) services to students for the purpose of fostering educational opportunities and academic success. The purpose of SSSP services is to bring the student and the District into agreement regarding the student's educational goal through the District's established programs, policies, and requirements; this agreement is implemented by means of the Student Educational Plan.

The Superintendent/President shall establish procedures to ensure implementation of matriculation services that comply with the Title 5 regulations.
