REVISION OF THE COLLEGE OF THE SEQUOIAS MISSION STATEMENT

Issue/Background Information

The College of the Sequoias Integrated Planning Manual timeline requires the District Governance Senate (DGS) to convene a task force every three years to survey district stakeholders for feedback on the Mission Statement. On February 11, 2025 (1st Read), the DGS carefully reviewed all feedback from the Mission Statement Task Force and provided input on the recommended Mission Statement. On February 25, 2025 (2nd Read), the DGS approved the proposed mission:

Proposed New College of the Sequoias Mission Statement:

Sequoias Community College District, as a designated Hispanic-Serving Institution, provides excellent, accessible, and equity-minded higher education to our diverse student population, regardless of background. We believe in students achieving their full educational potential and support teaching, student learning, and success in attaining a variety of degrees and certificates, from basic skills to transfer education and workforce development.

Current College of the Sequoias Mission Statement:

Sequoias Community College District provides excellent higher education in a spirit of equity for our diverse student population. We believe in students achieving their full educational potential and support student success in attaining a variety of degrees and certificates, from basic skills to transfer education and workforce development (Reaffirmed by the Board of Trustees on March 8, 2021).

Recommended Action

It is recommended that the Board of Trustees approve the revised Mission Statement recommended by the District Governance Senate.
