In Accordance with Education Code Section 15280, the following report is the fulfillment of the committee's annual requirement.

Measure C was approved by the voters on November 7, 2006. A Bond Resolution was adopted and signed by the Governing Board on July 17, 2006, and is available on the COS website at: www.cos.edu (Click on Measure C Hanford Bond).

Measure C required the creation of a Citizen's Oversight Committee. The purpose of the Citizens' Oversight Committee is to inform the public concerning the expenditure of bond revenues. The Committee is charged with actively reviewing and reporting on the proper expenditure of taxpayers' money for school construction. Citizens' Oversight

Committee shall advise the public whether the community college district is in compliance with the requirements of paragraph (3) of subdivision (b) of Section 1 of Article XIIIA of the California Constitution.

Based on this information, as of July 22, 2008, the Citizen's Oversight Committee finds that the bond revenues were expended only on the specific projects approved by the voters and that no funds were used for any teacher or administrative salaries or other school operating expenses.
