### A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE COLLEGE OF THE SEQUOIAS COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT TO ADOPT A PLAN FOR ADJUSTMENT OF THE TRUSTEE AREAS

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2022-01**

1. **WHEREAS**, California Education Code section 5019.5 requires the governing board of the College of the Sequoias Community College District (the "District") to adjust the boundaries of the District's current trustee areas to equalize the population following each decennial federal census; and

2. **WHEREAS**, on October 11, 2021, the Board of Trustees of the District (the "Board") held a public meeting to receive a presentation from the District's retained special voting rights counsel regarding the legal and policy criteria governing redistricting, and from the District's retained demographer, Lapkoff & Gobalet Demographic Research, Inc., on certain demographic information regarding the current trustee areas, based on adjusted, "validated" 2020 Census data; and

3. **WHEREAS**, on October 25, 2021, the Board received another presentation from its special voting rights counsel and retained demographer, and reviewed and adopted criteria that should guide the adjustment of the District's trustee area boundaries based on the 2020 Census data; and

4. **WHEREAS**, the retained demographer thereafter formulated possible alternative redistricting scenarios for review by the public at a public hearing and for consideration by the Board of Trustees, based on the criteria adopted by the Board at its October 25, 2021 meeting; and

5. **WHEREAS**, at a public meeting on November 8, 2021, the District's retained demographer presented a draft map (Plan 1) which was developed according to the criteria set forth above, for the consideration of the Board of Trustees and the public, and was posted to the District's website for public viewing; and

6. **WHEREAS,** at the conclusion of the public meeting on redistricting on November 8, 2021, the Board of Trustees directed the demographer to formulate additional trustee area plan scenarios for consideration at a future public meeting; and

7. WHEREAS, at a duly-noticed meeting and public hearing of the Board on December 13, 2021, the demographer presented the draft trustee area plan developed for the November Board meeting (Plan 1), along with additional draft trustee area plans (Plans 2, 3 & 4), which also were posted to the District's website, for review by the Board of Trustees and the public; and

8. **WHEREAS,** following the presentation of the draft plans on December 13, the Board of Trustees held a duly-noticed public hearing to receive testimony from the public regarding the draft plans, after which the Board directed the demographer to finalize the draft plans for consideration of the Board at a subsequent public meeting; and

9. **WHEREAS,** at the duly-noticed public hearing and meeting of the Board on January 10, 2022, the demographer presented four finalized draft plans (Plans 1, 2, 3 and 4), for the consideration of the Board of Trustees and the public (Plans 1, 2, 3 and 4 are attached hereto as Exhibit A); and

10. **WHEREAS,** Following the presentation of the four draft plans on January 10, the Board held another duly-noticed public hearing to solicit any final public testimony regarding the four draft plans before the Board voted to adopt a final plan; and

11. **WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees has considered all public comment on the plans; and

12. **WHEREAS**, the population in the proposed trustee areas of all four draft trustee area plans (Plans 1, 2, 3 and 4) are substantially equal, as defined by law; and

13. **WHEREAS,** all four draft trustee area plans (Plans 1, 2, 3 and 4) comply with the federal Voting Rights Act, and with all applicable laws and regulations set forth in the California Education Code and the California Elections Code; and

14. **WHEREAS,** the Board of Trustees prefers the trustee area boundaries in proposed Plan <u>1</u> because the Board believes that Plan <u>1</u> better adheres to the redistricting criteria adopted by the Board; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the District hereby finds, determines, declares, and resolves as follows:

Section 1. <u>Determination of Recitals</u>. The above recitals are true and correct.

**Section 2.** Adoption of Plan for Adjustment of the Trustee Areas. The Board of Trustees does hereby adopt Plan <u>1</u>, attached hereto as Exhibit "B" and incorporated herein by this reference, as the trustee area plan to be used in the District's elections on November 8, 2022, and thereafter.

**Section 3.** <u>Direction to Staff</u>. Staff, including the District's retained demographer when working with the Registrar(s) of Voters during plan implementation and adjustment of precinct configurations, are authorized to make required technical amendments to the new redistricting plan that do not substantively affect the populations in the districts, the district boundaries, compliance with the Board's redistricting criteria or the intent of this resolution, and shall advise the Board of any such amendments that are found to be required in plan implementation.

**Section 4.** <u>Delegation of Authority</u>. The Superintendent and/or his designee shall take all actions necessary to provide whatever assistance may be required by the Elections Departments of Kings and Tulare Counties, and to complete the process in a timely fashion to permit implementation of these trustee areas in connection with the District elections to be held on November 8, 2022.

**Section 5.** <u>Effective Date</u>. This Resolution shall be effective as of the earliest day possible under the law until otherwise rescinded by the Board.




## Comparision of Plans 1, 2.1, 3, and 4, with Number of Persons Changing Trustee Areas






Minimum Change Plan 1 (black boundaries; Current Wards (color shaded)




