The president will only fund the items deemed mandatory/necessary by Senior Management. If Governor's May Revise reduces funding, adjustments will be made to the list. Tier I priorities will require on-going base budget augmentation of \$1,351,263 of new General Fund Unrestricted (GFU) funding. There are no Tier II funding priorities.
