STUDENT SENATE ELECTIONS

The Student Senate shall conduct annual elections to elect officers. The elections shall be conducted in accordance with procedures established by the Student Senate Constitution.

Any student elected as an officer in the Student Senate shall meet the following requirements:

The student shall be enrolled in the Sequoias Community College District ~~District~~ at the time of election and throughout his or her term of office, with a minimum of nine (9) semester units. The student shall meet and maintain the minimum standards of a 2.0 GPA, have a College of Sequoias Student ID Card with current Activity Benefits Sticker and serve a term of one school year (fall and spring semester). The student must enroll in the Leadership Class (2 units). ~~Additionally, the Student Trustee and Student Senate President must maintain a 2.5 GPA and be enrolled in 12 units 2.75 GPA and be enrolled in and complete a minimum of nine (9) units.~~

The Student Senate General Election (online) shall be held in the Spring semester, no later than the third week of May, for the purpose of electing the officers for the following term of office. If there is a vacancy, they will be appointed ~~during~~ **by** the first two weeks of the semester by the ~~Vice President or Board~~. **Student Senate membership committee.**

The spring elections shall be held for the officers of: Student Senate President; Student Senate Vice President; Commissioner of Activities; Student Trustee; Student Body Ambassador; Commissioner of Clubs; Commissioner of Finance; Commissioner of Records, and Commissioner of Publicity ~~and Arts~~.

For the offices of Student Senate President and Vice President and **Student Trustee**, the candidates must have completed at least one (1) semester of the Leadership Class, have knowledge of parliamentary procedures according to Robert's Rules of Order and have demonstrated effective leadership skills.

A candidate must complete a signed **application** ~~petition~~ and submit it to the Student Senate Advisor by the assigned deadline date. The Advisor of the Student Executive Board shall determine the eligibility of the candidate. Once a candidate has been approved to run for an office, they can begin their campaign efforts by posting materials or distributing information. All campaign materials must be approved in the Student Activities & Affairs Office prior to posting. ~~Students are allowed to campaign one week prior to the election dates. Elections will be conducted online.~~

The election shall be held ~~by an online election in Banner Web~~ **through a student portal which verifies current student status**. The Student Senate Vice President will

serve as the election chairperson (unless he/she is a candidate). The Student Senate President may serve as chairperson at that time, or appoint a member

of the Leadership Class. All candidates and campaign materials must remain one hundred (100) feet away from the Student Activities and Affairs Office.

Any current student enrolled in the District is eligible to vote in the online spring elections.
