**Meeting(s) Report:**

**1. Item not on Agenda:**

Dave updated the committee on a recent cyber-attack targeting Instructure, noting there is no evidence of COS data being compromised. The situation is under continuous review, with ongoing updates to senior management and communication with Instructure.

**2. Completed Project Update:**

Scenic lines to Hanford and Tulare campuses are now active, with work underway to establish proper routing and redundancy using Comcast connections. We've also added automation to reduce manual work for summer computer deployments, aiming for faster and less hands-on updates compared to previous years.

**3. Projects In progress:**

The deadline for Tittle II Digital ADA compliance was postponed until April 2027, allowing more time for districts to prepare. Degree Works implementation is scheduled for this summer. Meanwhile, proof of concept for the new website is currently under development in AWS, with L. Fishback handling the design elements.

**4. Future Projects:**

Planned initiatives include migrating SSO to Microsoft Entra, and the new user provisioning/deprovisioning.

**5. Technology Plan 2nd<sup>+</sup> Read:**

D. Richert presented the updated Technology Plan for a second read, highlighting the addition of initiative #4. The committee approved the plan to be submitted to District Governance Senate.

**6. Lab Software needs for Fall:**

D. Richert stated that faculty and staff should submit their requests for software installations in computer labs for the upcoming Fall term at this time, in accordance with procurement policy.
