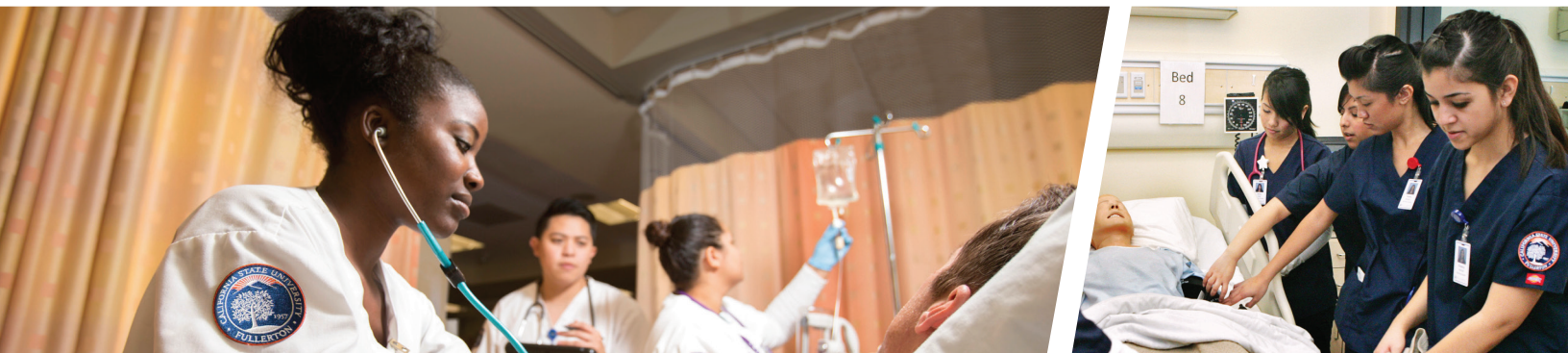

PROGRAM

The RN-BSN program is designed for Associate Degree and Diploma prepared RNs interested in advancing their degree to a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN).

Our program, with its strong curriculum and experienced faculty, provides a student with the opportunity to complete the program in two semesters attending full-time. This program also offers a flexible study plan where students can complete the program part-time to accommodate the working nurse.

Students have ongoing academic support from advisors, mentors and writing tutors.
