

# Requirements for EMT-1

1. NREMT Test - \$80 per test.
  - The testing center is located in Visalia, inside the Cigna building on Akers.
  
2. Live Scan (fingerprinting) - \$63
  - Can be done at the Tulare County Sheriffs Department, located at 2404 W. Burrel Ave Visalia, CA
  - You can print out the Live Scan request papers from [CCEMSA.org](http://CCEMSA.org)
  
3. Ambulance Drivers Handbook - \$5
  - Pick the handbook up at the DMV
  
4. State & County License Application- \$124
  - Dept. of Health, Fresno. 1221 Fulton Mall Fresno, CA
  - You will get your county license the same day you apply.
  
5. Palm Medical - \$80
  - For your physical exam clearance
  - 235 E. Noble Ave Visalia, CA
  
6. Ambulance Driver Written Test- \$25
  - You are allowed 3 tries per application fee of \$25.
  - You will need the following to take the written Ambulance Driver test:
    - CDL License Renewal paper, mark "Add Ambulance Certificate"
    - California Drivers License
    - EMT-1 License
    - Medical Examiners Paper (Physical)
    - Live Scan Request paper (signed & dated by Tulare County Sheriff's Department)
  
7. After everything is completed and you are ready to apply with an ambulance company, you will need the following:
  - 3 yr. driving printout from the DMV. The cost is \$5.
  - Your EMT-1 license
  - CPR Card
  - Drivers License
  - Medical Examiner's Paper (Physical)
