



**TULARE-KINGS POLICE ACADEMY & REGIONAL TRAINING CENTER  
AT THE COLLEGE OF THE SEQUOIAS  
TRAINING COURSE**

**COURSE DESCRIPTION:** This 8-Hour course is designed to update Law Enforcement Officers to the current standards for First Aid/CPR/AED as required by Title 22. Topics include all required AHA/Title 22 updates and include AED and First Aid/CPR skills, the use of assisted delivery of medication specific to the use of an Epi-Pen, Oral Glucose and Naloxone administration.

**UNIT CREDIT:** Non-credit course/no college registration required.

**COURSE FEE: \$90.00 *per participant*.** Enrollment is on a first-come basis. Please enroll your personnel as early as possible.
