COURSE DESCRIPTION: This 24-hour course will provide the trainee with the minimum topics to include Arrest & Control Techniques (PSP) (4 hours), Tactical Firearms (PSP) (4 hours), Use of Force (PSP) (4 hours), Strategic Communication (PSP) (4 hours) and Driving (PSP) (8 hours). This course meets all POST Perishable Skills and CPT training requirements.

COURSE FEE: \$90.00 Arrest & Control (PSP), \$100.00 Tactical Firearms (PSP), \$90.00 Use of Force (PSP), \$80.00 Strategic Communication (PSP) and \$120.00 Driving (PSP)
