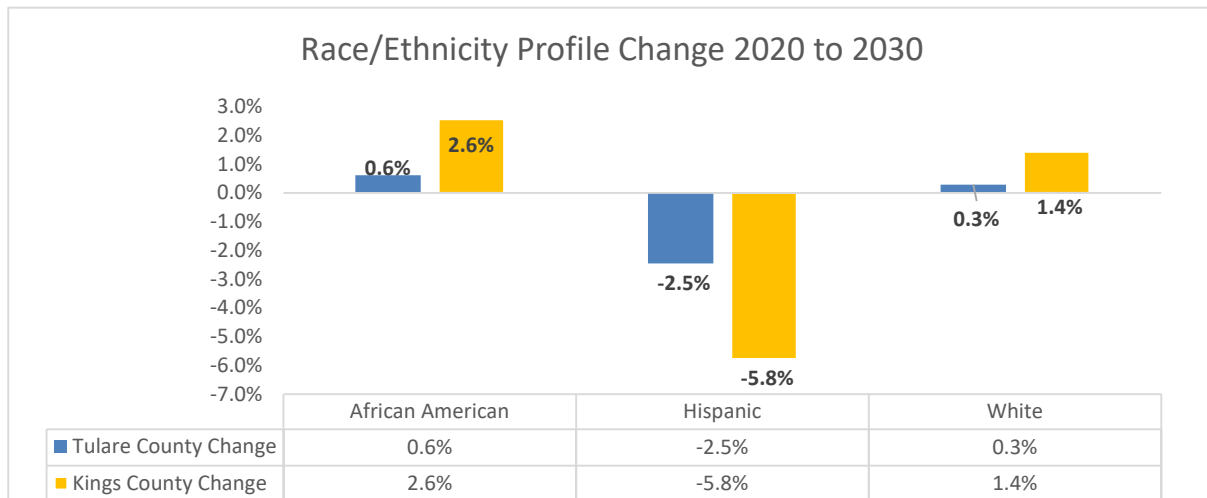


## Service Area Race/Ethnicity Profile Change
