
Service Area Income Levels



Both Tulare County (14.7%) and Kings County (13.7%) have poverty levels that exceed the statewide poverty rate (8.4%). In both Kings and Tulare Counties, families with female householders with no spouse present experience higher poverty rates, ranging from 28.4% to 30.9%, compared to the statewide average of 19.8%.
