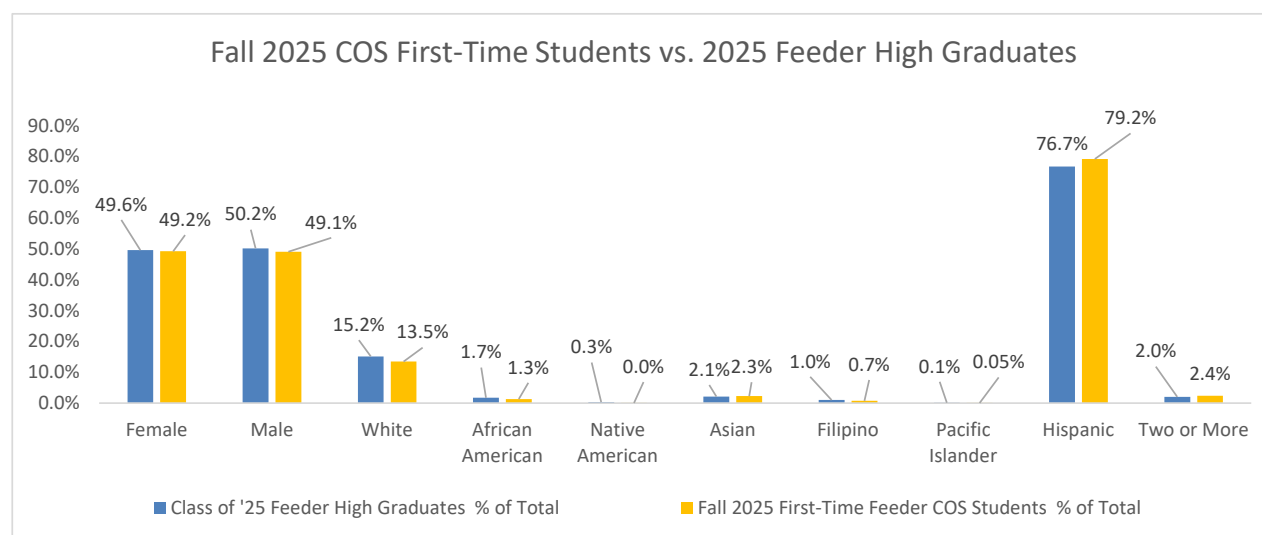


COS First-Time Students vs. Feeder High Graduates



The demographic distribution of first-time students enrolled in Fall 2025 closely mirrors the demographic distribution of student graduates from local feeder high schools. Hispanic students continue to represent the largest group (79.2%).
