Observations:

From 2025 to 2030, both Tulare County (2.1%) than Kings County (2.6%) are expected to grow at a faster rate than California (0.9%). Over the same period, Kings County’s proportion of Black and Hispanic populations are expected to increase by 0.6% and 0.3% respectively, while the White population is projected to decrease by 0.8%. In Tulare County, the Hispanic population proportion is projected to decrease by 0.3%, while the White population is projected to increase by 0.4%.
