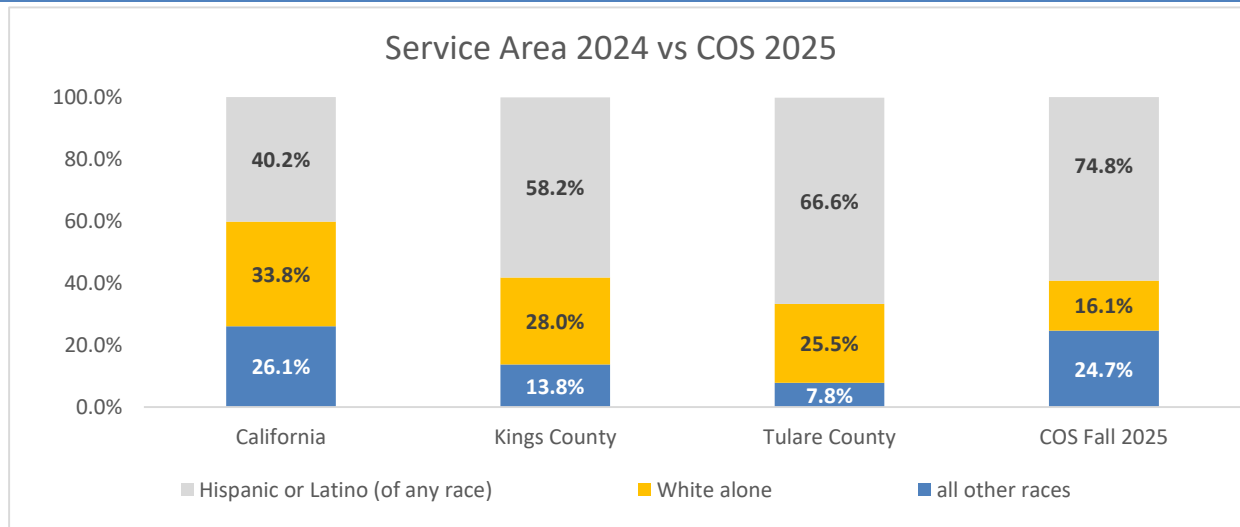


Service Area Population vs COS Population



The Sequoias Community College District is a Hispanic-Serving Institution (HSI) with a Hispanic student population of 74.8% in Fall 2025, which exceeds the service area Hispanic population that ranges from Kings County (58.2%) and Tulare County (66.6%).
