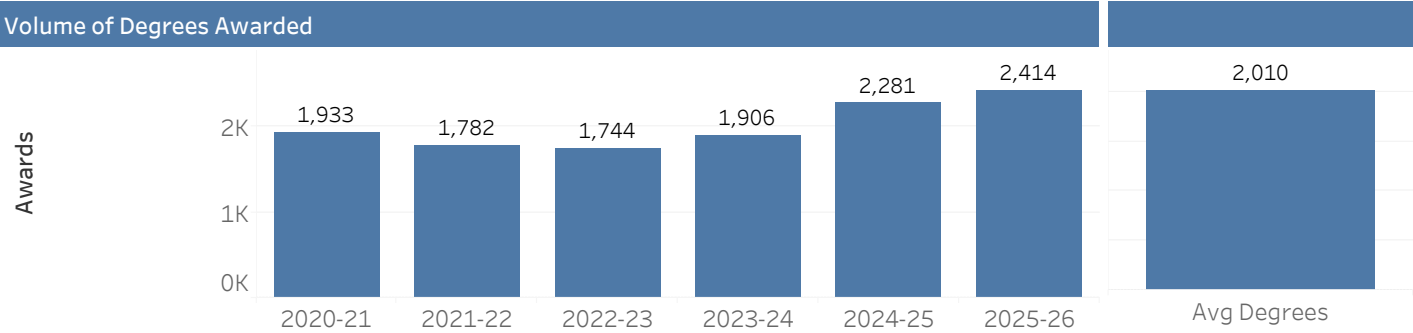
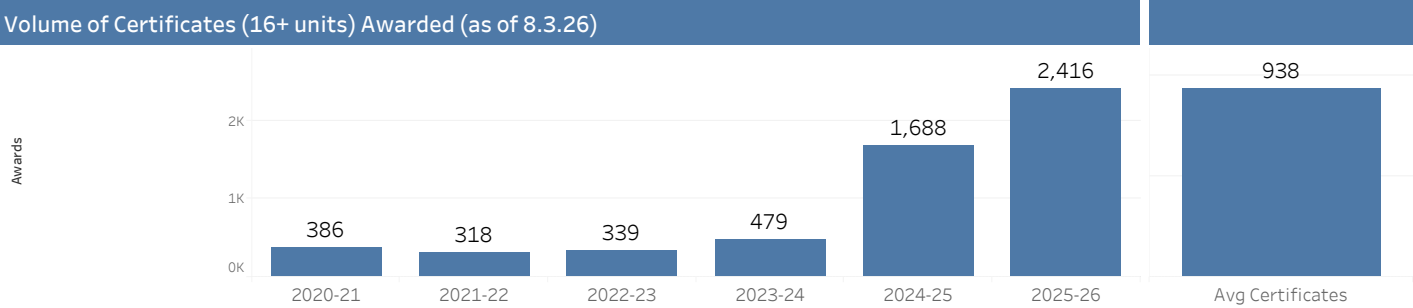


Awards as Reported to ACCJC (as of 8.3.26)



Observation:

In the 2025/26 year, the District exceeded the minimum institution-set standard of 1,868, and the aspirational goal of 2,261 degrees awarded. Over the past six years, the volume of degrees awarded has increased from 1,933 (20/21 Yr) to 2,414 (25/26 Yr).



Observation:

In 2025/26, the District awarded 2,416 certificates of 16+ units, which exceeded the minimum institution-set standard of 1,135, as well as the aspirational goal of 1,507. The large increase is due to the awarding of new general education certificates.
