Obtain copies of all your college transcripts and AP or IR Exam results. You can obtain

your COS unofficial transcript from Banner. Select "Student Records link" and then clic on "Print Unofficial Transcript."	
\square Identify the courses you will be enrolled in each term prior to transfer (e.g. If you are	9
applying for Fall transfer you need to know the courses you will take in Spring and Summer).

Additional Information you will need

- Annual Income If your parents claim you as a dependent on their tax return, you'll need to know their annual income (pre-tax). Refer to tax records or pay stubs.
- **Parent's residency** (optional) Know the date they moved to the state where they legally reside.
- Social Security Number (If you have one) Otherwise leave blank.
- Citizenship Status If you're not a U.S. citizen, know your immigration status and the type of visa you hold (such as F1).
- Method of payment If you are going to pay by credit card; know the account number, expiration date, cardholder's name and billing address.
